Features

- Aluminium radiators undergo specific multi-stage treatments before the final coating, making the external and internal surfaces highly resistant to the corrosive action of water in the system and the surrounding environment.
- Aluminium radiators undergo strict technological and aesthetical controls before the final leakage test to ensure they comply with the EN 442-1 standard.
- Aluminium radiators have a 10 year warranty.
- Aluminium radiators are supplied in pre-assembled stock sizes
- Sections can be easily added or removed if more or less are required.

Benefits

- **Fast response** - Aluminium's high conductivity allows it to respond instantly to changes in water temperature, which is, in turn, controlled by the thermostatic radiator valve responding to room temperature.
- **Efficient** - With the fast response times, the central heating can be timed on a "just-in-time" basis, never heating an empty house either prior to arrival or after departure.
- **Energy saving** - Low water content contributes to a substantial saving in energy.
- **Quick and simple to install** - Aluminium radiators reduce installation time and costs.
- **Easy to maintain** - Single sections can be added or removed as required.
